Please acknowledge the serious nature of, and the necessity for the formality and orderly conduct of a town board meeting to properly manage the business and affairs of the town. In general, the public is free to attend regular town board meetings, but (if) does not have a right to speak at a board meeting except as provided by board rules. A public comment period is scheduled at each meeting in which no member of the public shall be permitted to address the board unless recognized and in no event, may any such person speak for more than five minutes. No member of the public shall engage in any debate, demonstration, booing, hand clapping or otherwise disrupt the formality of the meeting. Any recognized speaker shall address their remarks to the town board, not other members of the audience, in an orderly and constructive manner.
